One was an image of St Chad's Cathedral by the Handsworth artist Joseph Frank Pimm (1900-1972) who studied at the Birmingham School for Art in Margaret Street and was a member of the RBSA. Representatives of the Moseley History Group visited St Chad's cathedral and presented the picture to the Dean, Monsignor Timothy Menezes on Friday, 10 January.
